



Immunization Requirements for Clinical: Advanced Nurse Aide Training

You must submit proof of your immunity to Signature Healthcare by the 1st day of class. We have provided an 'Immunization Status Form' for you to use (requires a physician's signature and clinic information) or you may submit approved copies of your immunization records to the office.

Advanced Nurse Aide Training:

Measles (Rubeola) - Must provide documentation of 2 injections at least one month apart with the second dose after age 15 months or sufficient titer levels. If you were born before 1/1/1957 you do not need proof of immunity.

Mumps – Must provide documentation of 2 injections or sufficient titer levels. If you were born before 1/1/1957 you do not need proof of immunity.

Rubella - Must provide documentation of 2 injections or sufficient titer levels. If you were born before 1/1/1957 you do not need proof of immunity.

Physical Examination: Must provide a physical examination signed by a doctor. A form is provided in this packet that you can take to your doctor if you don't already have one.

Tuberculin Test (TB) – Must provide documentation of PPD Skin Test by Mantoux. Test must be within 12 months of starting the program. Copy of chest X-ray and TB questionnaire must be completed for all positive TB skin tests.

Seasonal Flu Shot – Clinical locations may require you to wear a mask throughout the clinical experience if you did not receive the flu shot this year. The flu shot is not required, but recommended.

Hepatitis B – Not required or offered to the student. Student will receive a Fact Sheet from the CDC. If student does not have a record of the 3 series vaccination record or provide sufficient titer levels, the student must sign Hepatitis B waiver.
